MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING
(approved 11/98; 10/10)

SECTION 1 TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP:

Individual, Parent Affiliate, Institutional: Membership begins with the payment of dues for the current year. In order to maintain a “good standing” status, members shall continue to remit the membership fee on the one year anniversary of the last payment. A grace period of 60 days to remit the membership fee is allowed in order to maintain membership.

SECTION 2 MEMBERSHIP RIGHTS

Individual: Individual members have the right to vote for board members and by-law changes, receive a copy of all member benefits, and purchase products and attend events at the member discount.

Parent Affiliate: The four officers of each parent affiliate have the right to vote for board members and by-law changes, receive a copy of all member benefits, and purchase products and attend events at the member discount.

Institutional: Each school building membership has the right for one vote for board members and by-law changes and receives a copy of all member benefits. All educators at the building may purchase products and attend events at the member discount.

SECTION 3 EXCEPTIONS: Payment of dues for the current year shall determine good standing membership for purposes of voting in elections and for constitution and by-laws changes. Persons who have not yet renewed their memberships, despite the 60-day grace period accommodation, shall not receive ballots.
