



## **Ruth Wright Professional Development Scholarship**

### **Eligibility & Selection Procedures**

This scholarship was established in 1996 by the IAGC to provide financial support for educators who wish to enhance their knowledge of gifted education and improve their instructional skills. The scholarship is named in honor of Ruth Wright, a founding member and first president of IAGC.

One scholarship is awarded each year. The scholarship provides a complimentary one-day registration to the IAGC Annual Convention or other IAGC professional development offering of comparable price.

Any current IAGC member may apply for the Ruth Wright Professional Development Scholarship.

The Ruth Wright Professional Development Scholarship will be awarded to a candidate with a clearly articulated goal and set of outcomes for professional development.

The IAGC Awards & Scholarship Committee will review all applications and present its selection to the IAGC Board of Directors for final approval.

The recipient will be notified by January 1, with the formal announcement and recognition to be at the Annual IAGC Convention.
